

# Gas condensate (chemical substance)

Low-density [alkanes](#) liquids that usually stay gaseous in [subsurface reservoir](#) and [condensate](#) on the way up when reaching a [dew point](#).

The usual composition is [pentane \(C<sub>5</sub>\)](#) to [octane \(C<sub>8</sub>\)](#) with [specific gravity](#) 0.7 ÷ 0.88 (70 ÷ 29 °API ).

May include minor [organic](#) and [inorganic](#) chemical substances.
