

Wet Gas (chemical substance)

[Natural Gas](#) containing [liquid hydrocarbons](#) ([condensate](#) or [volatile oil](#)).

It normally happens in the wellbore under production on the way up to the surface when [Natural Gas](#) is getting depressurized and cooled.

Counter-intuitively it may not contain [water vapor](#) which makes the term [Wet Gas](#) a misnomer.

Typical [GOR](#) is < 100,000 scf/stb and the usual content of [methane](#) is > 85 %.

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
