A state of a [thermodynamic system](#) in which the sum of the forces, and torque, on each particle of the system is zero

Particularly in fluid dynamics it means that fluid pressure $p(t, \mathbf{r}) = \text{const}$ is defined for any spatial location \mathbf{r} at any moment of time t and it stays the same at all locations and not changing over time
