Natural or engineering facility maintaining the [bottom-hole pressure](#) below the pressure in [subsurface reservoir](#), connected to the [wellbore](#), and thus enforcing a flow from reservoir into a [wellbore](#) and further lift of the [wellbore](#) fluid up to the surface.
