

Temperature (physical property)

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A property of [Thermodynamic system](#) measuring a change of [internal energy](#) U with respect to the change of its [entropy](#) S :

(1)
$$T = \left(\frac{\partial U}{\partial S} \right)_{V,N}$$

with volume V and number of particles N being constant.
