

Fracture height = h_f

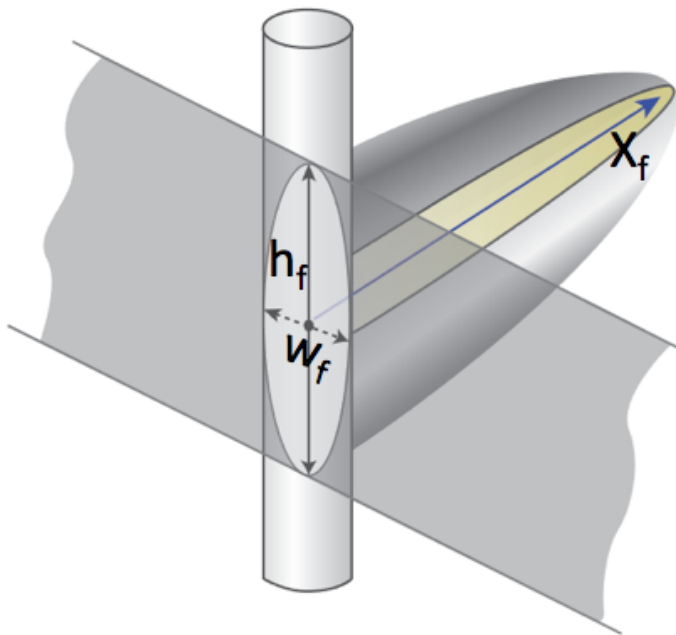


Fig. 1 – Hydraulic fracture schematic showing fracture half-length (x_f), fracture height (h_f) and fracture width (w_f).

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

The size h_f of the fracture from top to bottom (see **Fig. 1**).
