

Estimated Lifetime = ELT = t

Estimated time before reaching the point of economical production of the hydrocarbons.

ELT (sometimes referred to as **t**) is measured in time units and is usually presented in years.

Unlike **RPR** it gives more realistic expectations of the resources end of life.

Meantime the **ELT** is only an estimation and it depends on numerous factors which may affect the production economics in future.
